## **CMAS**

Here is the following schedule for the upcoming CMAS testing for 3rd-5th grade.

English Language Arts (ELA)	Grades 3, 4, and 5	April 13,14,15
Math	Grades 3, 4, and 5	April 20,21,22
Science	Grade 5 only	April 26,27,28

Please make sure that your child attends school on their testing days. This allows students the opportunity to test in their classrooms with their teacher. We also know that things come up, and we will be able to complete make-up tests through May 14<sup>th</sup>.

For students in 3rd, 4th, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade, there are three math sessions, each 65 minutes long, and three ELA sessions, each 80 minutes long. Fifth graders also have three science sessions of 80 minutes each. To avoid test fatigue, we only schedule one test session each day, in the morning. For our remote students, we plan to schedule test sessions at the same time in-person students are testing to ensure continuity of instruction.
