I wanted to begin by thanking everyone who attended last night's New Family BBQ! Thank you to our PTA and parent volunteers for helping to make the night a great success. It was wonderful to connect with so many of our new families-we are so glad to have you in our community!

Last night you received communication around the district recommendations to the school board regarding elementary school closures and consolidations. As you know, Stober will be a welcoming school for the students who currently attend New Classical Academy at Vivian and their community. This means that the proposal is for Stober to become the new boundary school for students who currently attend NCA beginning in the 23-24 school year. This does not mean that we are becoming a classical academy. Overall, our core instructional programming will remain the same. In addition, we will be collaborating with the NCA community to incorporate important aspects of their community to support our continual growth as a school. While the board decision will not be finalized until November, I am excited to partner with our collective school communities in order to provide increased opportunities, resources, and support for all of our students. I know that there are many logistical questions that you may have regarding this transition, and I assure you that as the year progresses, I will continue to update you on all of the details. Right now, it is my hope that as a Stober community we are taking this time to provide support to our Wheat Ridge area friends and neighbors as they navigate this difficult time.

On Monday, September 12 we will be holding an Informational Meeting for NCA families to welcome them to our building and to begin the work around collaborating across our school communities to ensure a meaningful and thoughtful transition. I am working closely with Michael Zweifel, the NCA Principal, and we are both strongly committed to working together to support everyone as we become one community.
