CMAS:

Colorado Measure of Academic Success. We will have three weeks of testing starting the first week in April. 3rd-5th grades will be testing in the morning from 8:30 am – 10:30 am, on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Monday's and Friday's will be make-up days. Some students will have accommodations.

Safe Routes to School:

 Anne and several parents were able to speak at the City Council Meeting. The City Council is committing to a continuous sidewalk on 20th. They talked about many ideas and will meet again next month.

Fees 2023/24:

- Jeffco is extending Tech for Ed for all Students 1st 5th so we will not have to fund Chromebooks anymore. We are in good shape to accommodate all of the kindergartners with Chromebooks. There will be a \$50.00 Tech fee for 1st through 5th grade that will cover all things, repairs, etc., and a \$25.00 technology fee for kindergartners
- Jeffco is moving into a new math curriculum, Illustrative Math. The district is coving the cost for the first year, so there will be no charge to the families. The only fees for the upcoming school year will be the technology and art sketchbook fees.

School Start Time:

• Next year's start time is 7:55am – 2:45pm, would like to do a soft start 20 minutes before, so doors open at 7:35am, maybe 7:40am soft start. It is calmer to have a soft start.

Construction Update:

- Construction will begin on March 17. They will move the lower temp. to the upper field next to the single temp. We will use the upper temps for classrooms at the beginning of next school year until the construction is complete. They will be adding 4 classrooms and a music room, 2 rooms up and three rooms down. The lower playground will be moved to the upper field. They are planning a sort of amphitheater where the swings are.
- The addition will not be done until after school starts, so we will have two 2nd grade classrooms utilizing the temps until the construction is completed.
- We are also getting a STEM Lab, compliments of the Gary Foundation. We will use one of the Temp. Buildings for that.

'23-'24 Enrollment/Staffing/Budget Update:

- Budgeted for 1.0 Instructional Coach, 1.0 Mental Health, .5 DTL, 14 classrooms, there will be no split grades for next year. Right now, we have 317 enrolled and the goal is 325. Kindergarten is full and we have a waiting list, but not enough to open up a third classroom. We hired four teachers and they were all top candidates. Some of our temporary teachers will not be back because we had to hire non-probationary displaced teachers.
- Izzy Harrison our SELS is leaving, we will have a substitute for the remainder of the year. We will have an ESL Teacher next year, not a tutor. We are waiting to hear if will be a 2.5 or 3.0 AMP team.
